### **Red**

- 1            Malbec, Mendoza                                  £20.95**  
*Deep dark red in colour. Fruity inviting nose of juicy black fruits, Plum & Cherries*
- 2            Vega Piedra, Rioja                                  £20.95**  
*Vibrant, Medium Bodied Rioja. Aromas of Ripe Berry Fruit with a balance of Juicy fruit & Soft Tannins*
- 3            Home Farm, Shiraz                                  £20.95**  
*Perfumed aroma that is dominated by raspberry, blackberry and liquorice, with a spicy black pepper lift. The palate is full of rich juicy fruit, and a long finish.*
- 4            Chilinero, Merlot                                  £20.95**  
*Fruity Merlot has intense black ripe fruit aromas of plums & Blackberries; Round Palate with soft tannins*

### **White**

- 5            El Otro Chardonnay, Cariñena, Spain            £20.95**  
*Very fresh and dry white wine from south east Spain. Citrus freshness and gentle floral texture from the Macabeo.*

*One of Italy's most popular white wines. Fresh, Dry White, Crisp & Delicate with a Zippy Citrus Twist*

*A well-known, Sweet white wine with a fruity flavour from the Mosel Region of Germany.*

**Domaines Andre Aubert**  
*Classic southern Rhone Syrah Grenache blend, medium weight, rich & juicy dark fruit flavour and a little peppery spice*
- 17 Crozes Hermitage £43.00**  
**Cave de Tain**  
*Ripe & juicy, predominately Syrah red wine made by Serra & Vedeau in collaboration with a number of small growers in the Rhone Valley*
- 18 Chateauneuf-du-Pape £63.00**  
**Domaine de Viex Lazaret**  
*This is without doubt one of the most splendid red Chateauneuf-du-Pape. It is deep in colour, smooth and simply beautiful.*

## Red Burgundy

- 19 Domaine De Mutellus Hautes £50.00**  
**Côtes De Nuits Peyroles**  
*Deep coloured, full & firm with lovely flavour*
- 20 Gevrey Chambertin 'Palanges' £90.00**  
**Domaine de Mutellus**  
*A rich elegant red wine with the purest Pinot Noir taste*

## White Burgundy

- 21 Mâcon Lugny Les Charmes £36.00**  
**Cave De Lugny**  
*A remarkable Macon, honey coloured and very rounded on the palate yet firm and flavourful. Much bigger than most Mâcons but without the sharp acidity – almost buttery.*
- 22 Saint Veran 'Merloix' £43.00**  
**Pierre Janny**  
*A delightful white wine from the Maconnais region of France. Full of fruit and wonderfully soft and well rounded. Equally at home with fish or meat. Over the hill from Pouilly Fuisse.*
- 23 Chablis £43.00**  
**Domaine de la Motte**  
*Great Classic this Chablis, Tastes mineral with notes of flint stone and fleshy fruits*
- 24 Chablis Premier Cru Beauroy £57.00**  
**Domaine de la Motte**  
*Fully Ripe Grapes result in a powerful wine. A distinctive, slightly Oaky style of Chablis Premier Cru*

## Red Bordeaux

- 25**     **Chateau Le Croix Du Chevalier, Medoc**     **£28.50**  
*Very good, traditional style of claret with a fair dose of Cabernet Franc, smooth & satisfying, good lunchtime claret*
- 26**     **Château La Croix Chantecaille**  
**Grand Cru, Saint Emilion**     **£48.00**  
*A full bodied wine from vineyards on the Pomerol border next to Château Cheval Blanc, aged for one year in 40% new oak, rich & soft with lovely plum flavours & essence of chocolate*
- 27**     **Chateau Pierrefitte,**     **£38.50**  
**Lalande de Pomerol**  
*Full bodied wine, Merlot & Cabernet Franc in equal proportions, 20 months in oak, with subtle aromas of truffles & pepper, soft tannin and excellent structure*
- 28**     **Reserve d'Angludet Margaux**     **£73.00**  
*Medium to full bodied elegant classic Margaux with real finesse. Ideal to accompany all red dishes and game.*

## Beaujolais

- 29**     **Domaine De Montangeron Fleurie**     **£38.00**  
*A ripe & supple wine, lightly oaked, from one of the best Vineyards in Beaujolais*
- 30**     **Le Cru du Volcan, Brouilly**     **£30.00**  
*Deep Ruby in Colour, nose of Liquorice & Marzipan with a Silky Balanced Finish*

## Loire - White

- 31**     **Raymond Morin Sauvignon**     **£24.00**  
*Popular, Crisp, Dry White from Loire Valley. Notes of Crunchy green apple, spring buds, perky passionfruit and crisp citrus.*
- 32**     **Pouilly Fume**     **£44.00**  
**Domaine des Fines Caillottes**  
*Made by probably the finest grower in the region combining a rich depth of fruit with stunning elegance*
- 33**     **Sancerre**     **£50.00**  
**Domaine La Merisiere**  
*Outstanding Sancerre showing the Sauvignon grape at its ripest & most intense*

## Provence - Rose

- 34**     **Domaine Houchart, Provence Rose**                     **£30.00**  
*Elegant, dry wine, with pale colour but full flavour  
& fruit made from Syrah, Grenache, Cinsault & Cabernet  
Sauvignon*

## Italy

- 35**     **Gavi di Gavi Nuovo Quadro,**                     **£33.00**  
**'La Battistina'**  
*Piedmontese white wine, dry, soft & very refreshing  
with a subtle initial prickle on the tongue*
- 36**     **Barolo Flori, Araldica**                                     **£47.00**  
*Outstanding value, with the tannins pleasantly  
supported by plump fruit and a round, silky texture*

## Spain

- 37**     **Pedro Martinez Alesanco,**                             **£26.50**  
**Rioja, Crianza**  
*A very good & most impressive Rioja,  
with good oak and rich, smooth blackberry flavours*

## English

- 38**     **Davenport, Horsmonden**                                     **£38.00**  
*Almost certainly the best performance of a Horsmonden Dry at  
only two years of age. Green fruit & honey, some nuance of Alsace  
and hint of Germany but plenty of Kent in there too.*

## Chile

- 39**     **Pacifico Sur Reserva, Pinot Noir**                             **£23.50**  
*Deep & rich with juicy dark berry & plum fruit in a medium  
bodied & conservative style*

## Argentina

- 40 Inacayal Vineyards Malbec** **£25.50**  
**Mendoza**  
*Easy drinking, well concentrated wine with flavours of plum & cherry fruit and some added complexity from barrel ageing*

## Australia

- 41 Deen De Bortoli, VAT 8, Shiraz** **£26.50**  
*Full bodied with intense colour & long, smooth palate*

## New Zealand

- 42 Aotea, Seifried Estate, Sauvignon** **£34.50**  
*The Seifried Sauvignon Blanc is typically varietal and pungent with passionfruit and gooseberry notes. The palate has good entry and length with lingering lime and feijoa notes.*
- 43 Seifried Estate Pinot Noir, Nelson** **£38.50**  
*Made from the oldest vines at the Rabbit Island vineyard, an earthy & savoury wine with notes of plum & violet and hints of oak & spice*

## South Africa

- 44 Franschoek Cellar Sauvignon** **£21.00**  
*Full bodied wine with grassy Sauvignon flavour and aromas of tropical fruit & citrus*
- 45 Klippenkop Pinotage** **£23.50**  
*Solid, medium bodied wine with plummy flavour and soft, smooth tannins*
